The claim of the petitioner for declaring him senior to Varinder Kumar as Assistant Secretary, employed with the Punjab School Education Board was allowed by this Court vide order dated 11.12.2015 **(Annexure P-1)** in *CWP No.3192 of 2014* with arrears of salary and consequential benefits for the relevant period.

Since, the needful was not done, hence, the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the respondents states that the dates of appointment of the petitioner have been anti-dated

and he placed senior to Varinder Kumar in the rank of Assistant Secretary and the subsequent promotional ranks of Deputy Secretary and Joint Secretary. He further submits that the consequential benefits of arrears of salary amounting to a sum of Rs.5,76,693/- stands paid, thus, the order in question has been complied with.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact of anti-dated promotions, as also payment.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of.

Rule is discharged.
