The petitioner had filed CWP No.11209 of 2015 to regularize his service with effect from the date, his juniors were regularized. The said writ petition was allowed by learned Single Judge of this Court, vide order dated 19.05.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) and impugned order dated 10.04.2015, rejecting the claim of the petitioner, was set aside. The respondents were directed to re-examine the case of the petitioner on par with his juniors, whose services have been regularized and to regularize the service of the petitioner from the date of his juniors. The said exercise was ordered to be completed within three months. Thereafter, respondents have preferred an appeal before the LPA Bench, which stands dismissed vide order dated 25.08.2017 (**Annexure P-2**) with costs of Rs.50,000/-, payable to the workman as compensation. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions stand complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
