Petitioner (Surinder Pal Singh) had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No. 13014 of 2017* seeking a Mandamus for conducting the demarcation of his agricultural land allegedly measuring 5 Kanals and 10 Marlas, Khasra No. 21//13/2, 14/1, situated in village Bagol Kalan, Tehsil Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by learned Single Judge of this Court vide order dated 02.06.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), directing the revenue officials to pass a speaking order on the grievance set out in the legal notice dated 10.05.2017 of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Since the needful was not done with the stipulated time of two months, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed, wherein a speaking order dated 15.11.2017 (**Annexure R-2**) on the legal notice stands passed. It is

also averred that the petitioner has since sold the land of his entire share.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has become infructuous, as the petitioner has since sold the land of his entire share, therefore, prays for withdrawal the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
