Both the parties are present in the Court. After long talk and detailed discussion as well as after allowing the child to meet the petitioner, it has come to light that the mother has not stopped her son, who is now 15 years old to meet his father. The Court also met Jiten who is 15 years old in the chamber. He is matured and sensible. He too stated that his mother has never stopped him from meeting his father. He himself does not want to meet him.

In view of the same, no contempt is made out against the respondent. However, in case, Jiten the minor son wants to meet his father, he will give him a call himself from his mother's phone.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner shall meet his son as and when his son gives him a call. In any case, the mother too shall ensure that Jiten calls the petitioner on the telephone from the mobile of his mother for meeting him. In case Jiten wishes to meet his father, then he should preferably call to meet on the same days as per the scheduled already fixed by the Court and thereafter they shall meet at the same place as already fixed.

In case, for some reasons, the son does not call his father at all for atleast three months, the petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application before this Court in this Contempt petition for reviewing the order passed today by this Court.
