AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Single Judge has granted relief of upgrading the regularization of the petitioner from Category 'D' to 'C', which relief has been granted to the petitioner. However, arrears along with interest, which were to be paid to the petitioner, have been stayed in a Letters Patent Appeal preferred by the respondent-State.

In the light of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous for now.

However, in case ultimately the stay, as granted by the Division Bench, is vacated qua the entitlement of the arrears to the petitioner along with interest or the Letters Patent Appeal is dismissed in toto and the cause

of action survives to the petitioner, the present contempt petition may be revived on an application to be filed by the petitioner.

Contempt petition stands disposed of with above observations

Rule issue to the respondents stands discharged subject to above.
