Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in pursuance of award passed by the Labour Court, an amount of Rs.1,05,642/- was paid and as per order passed by this Court on 22.03.2014 an amount of Rs. 1 lac in lump sum was ordered to be paid. A sum of Rs.5642/- is to be recovered from the petitioner.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the respondents, as an amount of Rs.1 lac has already been paid and recovery suit is stated to be pending.

The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner or order

has not been complied with, he is at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
