The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 30.11.2017, operative part of which reads as under:-

“Keeping in view the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the legal notice dated 24.08.2017 (Annexure P-24) and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of 6 months from the receipt of copy of this order.”

Replies have been filed on behalf of the respondents.

As per para 6 of the reply filed by respondent No.1, the matter has inquired into. Thereafter, seven FIRs have been investigated and final reports under Section 173 Cr.P.C. have been submitted before the respective trial courts. Report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.321 dated 28.7.2016 was also submitted before the trial court on 19.3.2018. The stands

complied with. The contempt is accordingly, dismissed.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law, if still aggrieved.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
