The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 3.3.2017 passed by this Court, vide which the competent authority was directed to make the payment to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record order dated 19.11.2018 passed in LPA No.1791 of 2018 challenging the order of the Single Bench dated 3.3.2017, vide which direction was issued in which, undertaking of learned senior counsel was recorded that the amount due would be deposited with the Registrar General of this Court within two weeks with a further liberty to respondent No.1-workman (since deceased) now represented through his LRs to withdraw the same.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record a copy of demand draft No.260148 dated 26.11.2018 amounting to ₹ 12,42,720/- drawn on State Bank of India, Kanak Mandi Hoshiarpur, vide which the said amount stands deposited with the Registrar General, Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed

in the present contempt petition, the same is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed.
