DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

Order dated 16.05.2016 passed in ***CWP No.16095 of 2012*** was to be complied with within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Said order was not complied with within the aforesaid period and the petitioners had to file the present contempt petition, wherein, notice of motion was issued on 15.11.2016. Even the reply was filed when cost was imposed for not filing reply. On 28.07.2017, the statement was made by learned State counsel while filing an affidavit that speaking orders have been passed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ms. Malka Rani, Senior Assistant, DPI (EE), submits that now only the payment is to be released to the petitioners by the Accountant General.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, it is directed that the necessary payment be released to the petitioners within a

period of two months from today.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, in case, the said payment is not released to the petitioners, they are at liberty to move an application for recalling of the order.
