DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that order dated 17.10.2014, vide which, the writ petition filed by him was disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur to intervene and take remedial action in accordance with law, which must serve the cause of public interest, has not been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the land was auctioned but the approval was not granted.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Inderjit Singh, Panchayat Secretary, Malerkotla-I submits that the matter has been sent for approval and auction is likely to be approved within a period of six weeks.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned State counsel,

the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction that necessary exercise be done within a period of six weeks from today.

In case the necessary action has not been taken within a period of six weeks, the petitioner is at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
