The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 27.04.2016.

It is not disputed that the petitioners have been regularized from the date when their juniors were regularized.

In view of the same, I find that order dated 27.04.2016 stands complied and the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed accordingly.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that respondents had filed SLP before Hon'ble the Apex Court, which was disposed of with the observations that benefits be given to the petitioners by treating them at par with other juniors. The petitioners have already been granted notional benefits. However, if the petitioners are still aggrieved with the relief, so granted to them or there is any discrepancy in the benefits so granted, they are at liberty to file representation or challenge the order dated 13.03.2018, in accordance with law.
