AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 21.10.2016 passed by this Court in CRM-37737-2016 (Annexure P-1) whereby notice was issued to respondent No. 2-Deputy Commissioner, District Gurdaspur to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner expeditiously within the framework of law preferably within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the certified copy of the order has been supplied to the respondents in the month of December, 2016. The said order passed by this Court has not been complied with.

Period of limitation as prescribed under the contempt of Courts Act is one year from the date of alleged filing. Period of limitation, therefore, starts from January, 2017. The present contempt petition is beyond the period of the limitation prescribed under the Act.

The contempt petition is, therefore, dismissed.
