Having considered the submissions of the petitioner and on going through the order dated 25.04.2017, which is alleged to have been violated by the respondent and the subsequent orders dated 11.07.2017 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.15086 of 2015, it cannot be said that the order passed by this Court on 25.04.2017 has, in any manner, been violated as on 25.04.2017, this Court had only made certain observations and the hearing of the case was deferred for seeking instructions with reference to the said observations. The subsequent order indicate that an affidavit had been filed by the counsel for the respondent on 11.07.2017 and thereafter the matter had been admitted by the Division Bench.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present contempt petition, the same stands dismissed.
