Counsel for the respondent has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of the District Controller, Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Ferozepur, dated 09.03.2018, according to which the claim of the petitioner has been duly considered and a speaking order dated 13.12.2017 (Annexure R-1) has been passed. An amount of ₹43,890/-, which was due for leave encashment, has also been credited to his account through R.T.G.S.

Counsel for the petitioner is not present despite the case having been called twice. It appears that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the matter, especially in the light of the fact that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with by the respondent.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
