Petitioner had filed a CWP No.17183 of 2015 seeking the release of monetary benefits which was disposed of vide order dated 12.07.2016 by this Court directing the Authorities to pay 9% interest on the delay payments w.e.f. 01.08.2013 till the date of actual payment and further regarding the income tax deducted from the arrears of salary of the petitioner, respondent-department shall issue requisite form and the petitioner can claim refund from the Income Tax Authorities as permissible in law. Since the order dated 12.07.2016 passed by this Court was not complied with. Hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Suresh Kumar

Jindal, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Mansa on behalf of

respondent no.1 has been filed wherein it is stated that the answering respondent has paid an amount of Rs.25, 484/- on account of interest vide cheque no.024527 dated 28.11.2016 and as such has complied with the order passed by this Court.

Counsel for the petitioner concedes to the aforesaid submission made on behalf of the respondent and submits that the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, present contempt petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
