The suit of the Petitioner for possession as also injunction from running a furnace or any other type of business in the suit premises was decreed vide judgment and decree dated 01.11.2017 passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge(Sr. Divn.), Fatehgarh Sahib. In the appeal filed by the defendants/respondent partial stay order was passed whereby the delivering of the possession in favour of the plaintiffs was stayed, however, there is no interim order regarding injunction operating against the defendants/appellants.

The present contempt has been filed for the alleged violation of the decree dated 01.11.2017 as the defendants are stated to be operating furnace.

At the time of hearing realising that the present contempt would
