Reply by way of affidavit dated 02.11.2018 of the Director General of Police, Haryana, has been filed in Court, taken on record. According to the said affidavit in the proceedings, which are pending before the Supreme Court, the contempt proceedings have been ordered to remain stayed. The Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.2178 of 2017 has also made a reference thereof in its order dated 22.01.2018 (Annexure R-1) while issuing notice in the application for condonation of delay.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as for the time being having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the contempt petition in case the order of stay is vacated by the Supreme Court and the LPA Bench or the Letter Patents Appeal and the SLP is dismissed.
