In compliance with the order dated 20.09.2018 passed by this Court, affidavit dated 23.10.2018 of the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, has been filed in Court, wherein in para-4, it has been specifically stated that report with regard to the security of the victim was called for, which was submitted on 24.05.2018 and as per the said report, there is no apprehension to her life and liberty and recommended to withdraw the security of the victim. Thereafter, DCP, Central Faridabad has passed an order dated 08.06.2018 to withdraw the security provided to the victim. However, Patrolling beat officer of the area and the PCR rider, who is on patrolling duty, have been asked to monitor and keep vigilance where victim is residing in the area of Panchsheel Colony Part-I Ismilepur, Faridabad. They have been further directed to provide necessary help to her as and when asked. As per the report of the SHO, Police Station Palla dated 16.10.2018, one rider motorcycle of PP Naveen Nagar, Police Station Palla has been

directed for patrolling in the residential area of the victim where no such activities regarding any imminent threat were found, therefore, the dedicated security has been withdrawn and patrolling officer has been directed to keep vigilance in the residential area of the victim.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of. However, in the light of the submissions made in para-4 of the affidavit, the victim would be provided all necessary help as and when required.
