The order dated 20.6.2017 passed in CWP No.13788 of 2017 was to be complied with within a period of three months from date of receipt of certified copy of the order. When the said order was not complied with within the prescribed period, the petitioner filed the present contempt petition, wherein notice was issued to the respondent on 21.11.2017. Neither the reply has been filed nor the order has been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been transferred but the order was not complied with within a period of three months. As per the case of the petitioner, copy of the order was supplied on 20.6.2017.

No doubt there is delay in complying with the order. The contempt petition is disposed of. However, an amount of Rs.10,000/- is imposed as cost upon the respondent, to be paid to the petitioner by way of demand draft.
