The present contempt petitioner has been preferred alleging non-compliance of the order dated 10.04.2015 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.541 of 1994, along with which, large number of writ petitions were disposed of.

Learned counsel for the State has brought to the notice of the Court the operative portion of the judgment in para 187, sub-para (iii), where number of those writ petitions, which were dismissed, have been mentioned. In the said writ petitions, number of the writ petition which was preferred by the petitioner i.e. CWP No.14532 of 1996 also figures.

In view of the above, the benefit of judgment passed in LPA No.541 of 1994, would not accrue to the petitioner. Therefore, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
