The petitioner retired on reaching the age of superannuation from the rank of Joint Director, Department of Director of Animal Husbandry w.e.f. 30.06.2007. A writ petition bearing *CWP No.3363 of 2012* filed by him, seeking payment of interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits was allowed vide order dated 17.10.2016, with a direction to pay the stated amount alongwith interest.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that on the previous date a statement was made that the entire payments have been released to the petitioner and thus the petitioner was sought time to seek

instructions, and if need be to implead the present incumbent.

Nothing of the sort has been done. In fact, none had appeared for the petitioner on the previous date, the position is same today also.

In view of the stand of the respondent, which is gone un rebutted, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.
