JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner is an owner an allegedly dilapidated premises wherein she had shop on the ground floor and was occupied by the alleged tenant Smt. Sheelawanti on the first floor. It was claimed that the said Sheelawanti was undertaking certain constructions on the first floor without permission of the landlord thereby causing severe damage to the premises on the ground floor. The petitioner filed CWP No.18123 of 2016 seeking a direction to the Municipal Corporation, Panipat for making a spot inspection and taking appropriate action so that there is no loss to life or property on account of its crumbling down.

This Court vide order dated 2.9.2016 disposed of the writ

petition with direction to the MC, Panipat to take appropriate action in

accordance with law.

Upon notice written statement has been filed wherein it is stated that there is a litigation pending between the petitioner and the said Sheelawanti with respect to the title of the property. That apart the representation has been decided with instruction to both the parties to demolish the building at their own level.

In view of the above, present contempt petition is hereby dismissed.
