Reply has been filed by the respondent stating therein that the grievance of the petitioners raised vide their legal notice dated 3.9.2012 has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 13.9.2017, which is placed on record as Annexure R-1.

In view of above, no further order is required to be passed in the present contempt petition. The same is dismissed accordingly.

However, in case the petitioners are still aggrieved, they are at liberty to file representation before the respondent within a period of four weeks from today, which shall be considered in accordance with law.
