The petitioner, who was working as Lecturer, had filed CWP No.21734 of 2016, challenging his transfer order dated 06.08.2016, transferring him from Government High School Nagla to Government High School Arjawar. The said petition was disposed of by learned Single Judge of this Court, vide order dated 20.10.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with direction to the respondent/Additional Chief Secretary to consider and decide the representations of the petitioner in accordance with law within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of that order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit dated 14/17.02.2017 of Sh. M.L.Kaushik, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the claim of the petitioner has been considered

and the representation of the petitioner has been declined by passing speaking order dated 09.02.2017 (**Annexure R-1**).

Learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions stand complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
