Reply on behalf of Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala dated 18.07.2018 has been filed in Court, according to which, petitioner has been treated as compulsorily retired as per the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 11616 of 2014. Arrears of pension amounting to ₹8,94,046/- have been released to the petitioner by way of Cheque No. 714372 dated 06.10.2017 and arrears of gratuity amounting to ₹57,128/- paid through Cheque No. 883757 dated 07.11.2017. All the payments have been made to the petitioner as per his entitlement and now the petitioner is getting regular pension from the respondents.

In view of the affidavit, which has been filed in Court today, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.
