The petitioner, while working as JBT Teacher in the Education Department, Haryana, had filed CWP No.23486 of 2016, challenged his transfer order dated 17.09.2016. The said petition was disposed of by learned Single Judge of this Court, vide order dated 15.11.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with direction to the competent Authority/respondent(s) to look into the grievance of the petitioner as set out in the representations and take a decision on the same within a week from the date of receipt of certified copy of that order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit dated 28.03.2017 of Sh. S.S.Phulia, Director, Elementary Education, Haryana stands filed, wherein it is stated that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and it has been decided that such teachers like petitioners shall be provided another opportunity in the near future in the next phase of transfer so that they can get the convenient station as per their willingness, weightage and eligibility, by passing a detailed speaking order dated 27.12.2016 (**Annexure R-1**).

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions were to decide the matter, which stand complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed as infructuous.
