The petitioner is the elected Panch of Gram Panchayat Kankrola, Tehsil and District Gurgaon. He had challenged his suspension and the issue is pending consideration in LPA No.936 of 2017, listed for hearing on 10.04.2018.

By filing the present contempt petition, it is averred that an interim order dated 31.05.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) was passed in the aforesaid LPA No.936 of 2017, whereby the suspension of the petitioner as Panch was ordered to be stayed, however, the petitioner was not being allowed to participate as Panch.

Upon notice, reply by way of an affidavit dated 22.01.2018 of respondent-Birender Yadav, BDPO, Gurgaon has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned opposite Counsel. In the said affidavit, it is submitted that in compliance of the interim order dated 31.05.2017 (**P-1**), letter dated 27.06.2017 (**Annexure R-1**)

associate the petitioner in the proceedings of the Gram Panchayat and the honorarium as Panch has also been paid to the petitioner at par with other Panches.

In view of above, it is evident that there is no willful disobedience, warranting continuation of the present contempt petition.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
