The petitioner was working as Assistant with the respondent-Department and was suspended on 07.01.1997 for lodging of a criminal case against him. He was acquitted by the trial Court, vide judgment dated 07.09.1999. On his reinstatement, he had relied upon the provisions of Rule 7.5 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Volume-I (as applicable to the State of Haryana) and sought full pay and allowances for the period, he remained suspended. However, his request had been declined by the Department, vide impugned order dated 02.12.1999 with the direction that his suspension period would be treated as leave of the kind due. Aggrieved against the same, he had filed CWP No.14365 of 2001, which was allowed by this Court, vide order dated 01.12.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) and the petitioner was held entitled to full pay and allowances during the period, he remained under suspension. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition on the ground that the aforesaid directions have already been complied with.

In view of the statement made by learned Counsel for the petitioner at Bar, the present contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
