The petitioner claims to be the Proprietor to the extent of his share in the Proprietary Body of Panna Singhan, Village Dadri, Tehsil Charkhi Dadri. On account of the acquisition of the land belonging to the Proprietary Body, the Proprietors had claimed the amount of compensation to the extent of their shares. Learned Division Bench of this Court, vide order dated 02.05.2016 (**Annexure P-1**), had directed the Authorities concerned to ascertain the facts and disburse the amount of compensation to the true owners. In compliance, an order dated 30.03.2017 (**Annexure R-2**) stands passed by the Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estates, Hisar. A perusal of the same reveals that the total amount of compensation stands deposited before the Reference Court/ADJ, Bhiwani. The Proprietors would be entitled to get the compensation released from the Court on determination of their individual shares in compliance of the orders passed by learned Division Bench of this Court.

At the time of hearing, it is conceded that the individual shares of the Proprietors have been determined by the Tehsildar Charkhi Dadri.

In view of the individual shares having been determined, the petitioners would be free to get the same released before the Court concerned.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
