It is an admitted position that the remaining amount of ₹5 lacs
has been paid to the petitioner on 15.11.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents
are liable to pay interest on the said amount as there has been delay on the
part of the respondents.

A perusal of the settlement would not indicate that there was
any mention of interest being paid in case of the cheques not being
honoured or there being delay on the part of the respondents in payment of
the said amount. The Court would, therefore, not comment upon the matter.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been
rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
