AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.15001 of 2016, titled as 'Dharampal & others Vs. State of Haryana & others'.

Perusal of the affidavit dated 16.03.2017 filed by the Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar, shows that on the representation of the petitioner, FIR No.115 dated 28.10.2016, under Sections 379 and 427 of IPC, stands registered at Police Station Jathlana, District Yamuna Nagar.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Yunus Ali, P.S. Jathlana, informs the Court that the challan has already been presented in the said FIR and accused Jai Bhagwan has been arrested, against whom, proceeding are going on before the trial Court after framing of charge and the next date of hearing is 30.08.2018. As regards the allegations with

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regard to encroachment/ unauthorized occupation on land bearing khasra No.103, which belongs to gram panchayat, proceedings for ejectment have been initiated against Lekh Raj son of Rulia Ram under Section 7 (2) of the Punjab Village Common Lands Act, 1961, which is pending with the Assistant Collector.

In the light of the reply, which has been filed by the respondent and the information supplied by the learned State counsel, on instructions, this Court is satisfied that the orders passed by this Court have been duly complied with. In case the petitioner is aggrieved or is not satisfied with the response of the respondent, he may avail of his remedy in accordance with law.

The present contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
