Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute this fact. He, however, states that the petitioner is also entitled to interest from the respondents, which has not been granted to the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondents states that the petitioner is not entitled to the interest as per the Policy.

Be that as it may, it is open to the petitioner to avail of his remedy, in accordance with law, with regard to his claim of interest.
