The petitioner (Gurbachan Kaur), alleges the violation of the order dated 01.05.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), passed in *CWP No.8983 of 2017*, whereby this Court, while disposing of the petition, had directed to respondent No.2 therein '*to consider and decide her legal notice dated 03.03.2017, in accordance with rules and pass a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.*'

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated period, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply by way of affidavit of Shri R.K. Pachnanda, IPS, Director General, ITBPF, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road,

New Delhi/respondent, has been filed in Court today, wherein in para No.3, it is stated that the legal notice dated 03.03.2017 of the petitioner has been considered and decided, by passing a speaking order dated 23.11.2017 (**Annexure R-1**), rejecting her claim for terminal benefits of her son.

In view of above, learned counsel for the respondent states that the order dated 01.05.2017 (**P-1**) has been complied with and no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
