The petitioner filed writ petition bearing *CWP No.9294 of 1993* and vide decision dated 21.01.2010, was held entitled to pay scale as granted to the other classes of persons within the same Group i.e. Group-XII of Electricity Board. Thereafter, the arrears were already calculated and paid.

In para No.3 of the affidavit dated 25.06.2015 of Shri K.D. Chaudhri, Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, it has been categorically stated that the petitioner was granted the equivalent pay scale of Rs. 2000-3500, as directed in compliance of the order as enumerated in the speaking order dated 21.08.2013. The petitioner was not found entitled to payment of arrears in the said granted

pay scale, as he was already drawing higher emoluments in the earlier/old pay scale.

It is stated that a speaking order dated 10.06.2015 (**Annexure R-1**) to that effect stands passed, hence, it is contended by the counsel for respondent that the order stands duly complied with.

In view of the stand of the respondent, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition.

Dismissed.
