The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 20.9.2017, vide which the respondents were directed to decide the representation dated 21.8.2017 filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Rahul Gupta, PCS, Addl. Managing Director (G), Markfed House, Chandigarh dated 21.11.2018 has been filed in Court today.

As per reply, the representation has since been decided vide order dated 7.2.2018, which is placed on record as Annexure R-1.

In view of the above, this Court finds that the order has been complied with and the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. The same is accordingly dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved with the passing of the order, which as per the reply stands communicated to him, he is at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.

The Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
