Learned counsel contends that despite order of the Hon'ble Division Bench dated 10.10.2017, in CWP No.23048 of 2017, directing the respondents to respond to application dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P-15) having been served on the respondents, no compliance has been made in respect thereto till date by the competent authority i.e. respondent No.2.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the contempt petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to decide application dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P-15) by passing a speaking order within a stipulated period of time.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jaswinder Singh, Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and states that the contempt petition be disposed of in terms of prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to decide the petitioner's application dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P-15) by passing a speaking order in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within a period of 4 weeks from today.
