The petitioners are the LR's of one Balvir Singh and contends that inspite of the stay order passed by the Revisional Court, the entries pursuant to the orders passed by the Commissioner (Appellate Court) were accepted and entries in the revenue record regarding the proprietary rights in equal shares of the three LR's of Dan Singh was recorded. The dispute thus is between Balvir Singh, his brother Mehar Singh and the sister-Bachan Kaur. The LR's of Balvir Singh are the petitioners herein; Mehar Singh is respondent No.2 herein and respondent Nos.3 to 6 are the LR's of Bachan Kaur.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the statement made by learned Counsel for the petitioners at Bar, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
