The petitioner had filed CWP No.18462 of 2017, seeking directions to the respondents to release the land measuring 17 marlas or pay suitable compensation or allot an alternative plot of the same value in the same locality. The said writ petition was disposed of by learned Single Judge of this Court, vide order dated 21.08.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 04.04.2017 of the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of that order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, status report by way of affidavit dated 19.02.2018 of Sh. Satyender Duhan, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala has been filed in Court, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned opposite Counsel. In the reply, it is submitted that the representation of the petitioner has been considered and the same has

been decided by passing a speaking order dated 13.02.2018 (**Annexure R-4**).

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions stand complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

In view of above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
