JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The order of termination of the petitioner as 'Helper' in PEPSU Road Transport Corporation (PRTC) was ordered to be modified into 'Compulsory Retirement' by this Court vide order dated 20.10.2009 **(Annexure P-3)** in the proceedings emerging out of a civil suit, which was also upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 29.07.2015 **(Annexure P-4)**. It was ordered that upon the substitution of the punishment of 'Compulsory Retirement', the petitioner would be entitled to release of his retiral benefits.

Since the retiral benefits were not released, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply stands filed.

Counsel for the respondent-PRTC points out from the para 5 of the affidavit/reply that entire retiral benefits have since been paid to the petitioner, although in the way of phased manner, therefore, states that no

further action is warranted in the present contempt petition and the same is liable to be dismissed.

Dismissed.

Rule stands discharged.
