JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner is employed as a Driver by Haryana Roadways and had, by filing CWP No.19826 of 2017, challenged his transfer from Jhajjar to Faridabad within two months of his posting at Jhajjar, being in violation of the Policy Guidelines dated 06.10.2004. The said writ petition along with others was allowed by this Court, vide order dated 01.09.2017. Since the petitioner was not being permitted to join back at place of earlier posting at Jhajjar, the present contempt petition was filed.

Upon notice, reply has been filed by Sh. Lekh Raj, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Jhajjar. In the reply, it is stated that vide order dated 01.01.2018, the previous transfer order has been recalled and the petitioner has been allowed to join back at Jhajjar, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
