It is not disputed that the order dated 25.07.2017 has been complied with while passing a speaking order dated 23.02.2018 vide which the petitioner was found entitled to the benefit of past service.

In this view of the matter, the contempt petition has become infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, states that no interest is paid. If that is so, he may approach the respondents-authorities by way of a representation within a period of four weeks which shall be considered and decided in accordance with law, within further four weeks from the date of making such representation.
