The petitioners were selected as Clerks by the Haryana Staff Selection Board in the year 1987, however, were offered appointments in May, 2013 upon the orders passed by this Court. Their claim for deemed appointment w.e.f. 12.04.1990 alongwith notional benefits etc with effect from the date their juniors in merit were appointment was required to be decided in compliance of the directions passed by this Court on 30.09.2015 (**Anneuxre P-1**) passed in the subsequent writ petitions.

Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing today, an affidavit dated 17.04.2018

of Ms. Dheera Khandelwal, Additional Chief Secretary, School Education Department, Haryana, has been filed, wherein in para No.7, it has been stated that the revised appointment letters have been issued, whereby the petitioners have been given deemed dates of appointment w.e.f. 12.04.1990 alongwith benefit of seniority and notional fixation of pay.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.
