The petitioners along with others, who were serving in the Punjab Police etc., had filed CWP No.1068 of 2006 for grant of Grade of Rs.3120-6200/- under the ACP Scheme as on 01.01.1996 along with all the consequential benefits. The said petition was allowed by this Court, vide order dated 09.09.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) in terms of CWP No.7005 of 2001, decided on 03.04.2014. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Susheel Kumar, PPS, SSP, Sri Muktsar Sahib stands filed, wherein it is stated that the claim of the petitioners along with others has been considered and the bills of leave encashment and DCRG (gratuity) of the petitioners and other eligible employees were sent to the District Treasury Officer, Sri Muktsar Sahib for payment.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions have already been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned opposite Counsel.

In view of above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
