JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners-Miller allege the violation of the interim order/directions dated 13.06.2006 (**Annexure P-1**), passed by this Court in *Civil Revision No. 3335 of 2006* filed by them, whereby the recovery of a sum of Rs. 11,44,424/- alongwith interest pursuant to Award dated 28.12.2001 (**Annexure P-2**), also upheld by the Objecting Court/District Judge, Ferozepur, vide order dated 13.05.2006 (**Annexure P-3**), stands stayed (subsequently duly confirmed), however, the respondents, by issuing notice dated 31.10.2017 (**Annexure P-7**) are seeking to take coercive steps to recover the said amount.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed by respondent No. 1 on behalf of the respondents, wherein it is stated that in view of the stay order dated 13.06.2006 (**P-1**), the Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited has issued instructions dated 15.02.2018 (**Annexure R-1/1**), that no

execution proceedings should be initiated till there is stay by the Hon'ble High Court.

In view of above factual position, counsel for the petitioners concedes that no further proceedings are warranted in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

Rule is discharged.
