Civil Writ Petition No.24563 of 2017 was preferred by Late Lt.Col.Pyara Singh Sarang, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 06.11.2017 (Annexure P-1), directing the respondent to consider the application of Lt.Col.Pyara Singh Sarang preferred under Section 22 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (hereinafter referred to "the 2007 Act"), for seeking eviction of unauthorized occupants. Decision on the said application was given by the respondent on 26.12.2017. After the passing of the order, unfortunately

Lt.Col.Pyara Singh Sarang has expired on 09.01.2018.

An application has been filed by the legal representatives of deceased Lt.Col.Pyara Singh Sarang for being impleaded as a party to the contempt petition.

Learned Senior Standing counsel for Union Territory, Chandigarh, states that there is litigation pending with regard to the succession of deceased Lt.Col.Pyara Singh Sarang.

In view of the above facts and in the light of the fact that the order passed by this Court, contempt of which was alleged, stands duly complied with by taking decision on the application preferred under Section 22 of the 2007 Act, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

Let the legal representatives of Lt.Col. Pyara Singh Sarang avail of their remedy in accordance with law.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

Since the main contempt petition stands disposed of, no orders are required to be passed on C.M. Nos.20300-301 CII of 2018.
