Present Contempt Petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of the Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner on the ground that the order dated 06.9.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed in CRM-M No.32839 of 2017 has not been complied with, whereas, the same was to be passed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

Learned State counsel states that a speaking order dated 05.12.2017 in compliance of order dated 06.9.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed in CRM-M-32839 of 2017 stands passed. She submits that thus there is

substantial compliance of the order.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted in the present petition.
