AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging violation of the order dated 01.06.2017. What has been asserted by the counsel for the petitioner is that the respondent has proceeded to put some mud on the site and in support thereof, reference has been made to the photographs (Annexure P-4).

2. Perusal of the said photographs would not, in any manner, indicate violation of the order dated 01.06.2017, whereby the Court had ordered that in the meantime, there shall be *status quo* qua possession and alienation of the plots. It is an admitted position that till date possession has not been transferred and no plots have been alienated.

3. In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same stands dismissed.
