In compliance with the order dated 07.09.2018 passed by this Court, affidavit of Director, Skill Development & Industrial Training Department Haryana dated 27.09.2018 has been filed in Court, taken on record, according to which, petitioner has been granted the consequential benefits except for regularization, which benefit could not be granted to him in the light of the Division Bench judgment of this Court passed in CWP No. 17206 of 2014 titled as Yogesh Tyagi and others vs. State of Haryana, decided on 31.05.2018, vide which the Policy of regularization of State of Haryana has been quashed. It has further been stated in the affidavit that in case, any favourable order is passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the SLP, which has been preferred, the petitioner would also be granted the benefit of regularization.

In view of the affidavit filed by the respondent, the present

contempt petition, for the time being, has been rendered infructuous.
