Learned State counsel has filed status report in the Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that facilities of water, electricity and sewerage are not there, whereas learned State counsel has given an assurance that facilities of water and electricity would be provided within a period of two months. It has also been undertaken that the sale deed will be executed thereafter only, as per the law and procedure.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned State counsel the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to

provide facilities of water and electricity within a period of two months. In case said facilities are not provided within a period of two months, the petitioner is at liberty to move application for revival of the contempt petition.
