JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Sunita Yadav, Lecturer (PGT) in Sociology, was posted at Government Senior Secondary School, Majra Sheoraj (2608) (Rewari). She filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No. 15777 of 2017* based on the grievance that her representation for transfer to Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Rewari (2541), as per her preference based on the transfer policy, has not been decided, the said writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 20.07.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to decide her legal notice within a period of three months.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time of three months, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, an affidavit dated 20.02.2018 of Sh. Rajiv Rattan, Director Secondary Education, Haryana, has been filed in Court today, the same is taken on record. In the reply, it is stated that the order

Yadav (petitioner) has been transferred to her place of preference at Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Rewari (2541).

In view of the above reply, learned State Counsel states that no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 5 (Namarata Kumari) states that his client has been wrongly transferred out without deciding representation in the true letter and spirit of the transfer policy.

After hearing counsel for respondent No. 5, this Court is of the view that his client is free to seek her remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as infructuous.

Respondent No. 5 (Namarata Kumari) is free to seek her remedy in accordance with law.

Rule is discharged.
